



GROUND WATER AUGMENTATION

Available: To all customers located in the general service area of the District.

Applicable: To service to ground water pumping systems used to augment water in a stream or reservoir. No other service from this meter or in conjunction with this use is allowed. Service shall be for a minimum initial period of 5 years and from year to year thereafter.

Character of Service: Alternating current, 60 cycles, single and three-phase, at any of the District's standard secondary voltages.

<u>Rates:</u>	<u>Summer</u>	<u>Winter</u>
Demand Charge, per kW:	\$2.85	\$2.85
Energy Charge, per kW:	\$.0625	\$.0625

Summer and Winter Seasons: The summer rates shall apply to customer bills rendered between June 15 and October 15. The winter rates shall apply to customer bills rendered in the remaining months of the year.

Production Cost Adjustment (PCA): A production cost adjustment may be applied to all energy charges based on the production cost adjustment received from the District's power supplier adjusted for line losses.

Minimum Bill: The monthly minimum bill shall be the fixed charge. The annual minimum shall be as stated in the contract of standard form.

Determination of Billing kW: The initial billing kW may be based on the horsepower of the motor. The District will install an indicating demand meter. The billing kW shall be the maximum metered demand from the in-service date and shall not fluctuate monthly or yearly. The demand meter will not be reset monthly.

Load Management: The District will install a remote-control switch on the customer's premise in such manner as to become part of the circuit controlling the pump motor. This switch shall be sealed or locked and shall be opened, adjusted, or modified only by district personnel. The power supply for the remote-control switch shall be obtained from the customer's metered power serving the pump motor controller. The District may interrupt service anytime during peak load conditions as determined by the district.

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Power Factor: If the power factor for the month (determined at District's option by permanent test of not less than 30 minutes duration under conditions which the District determined to be normal) is less than ninety percent (90%) at the point of delivery, the kW billing demand will be increased by multiplying by 90% and dividing by the power factor expressed in percent.

Municipal Lease Fee and/or Franchise Fee: When the District has an agreement to lease the electric distribution facilities of a village, the District agrees to pay the village a percentage of the revenue derived from the customers served from the facilities owned by the community. The lease or franchise amount shall be added to each customer's monthly bill.

Gross Revenue Tax Charge: Customers residing within the corporate limits of an incorporated town or village shall be charged 5% of the monthly bill as a gross revenue tax.

Late Charge: Accounts where payments have not been received by the due date indicated on the bill shall be assessed a late payment charge as described in the District's "Customer Service Charges Rate Schedule".

Nebraska State Sales Tax: The Nebraska state sales tax shall be applied to all charges unless a valid tax exemption certificate is filed by the customer.

Service Regulations: Service under this rate schedule is subject to the District's Rules and Regulations.
