**IRRIGATION SERVICE  
"FULL SERVICE"**

**Available:** To all customers located in the general service area of the District.

**Applicable:** To customers for electric irrigation pump motors, pivot irrigation wheel motors, re-use pits, booster pumps and on-farm related grain processing from the same district facilities serving the irrigation pump, or as outlined in section "Charge for Non-Irrigation Use" contained in this rate schedule.

**Character of Service:** Alternating current, 60 cycles, single and multiphase, at any of the District's standard secondary voltages.

**Irrigation Season:** The irrigation season shall be from May 1<sup>st</sup> through September 30<sup>th</sup>.

**Rates:**

**Horsepower Charge:**

\$51.00 per horsepower billed as follows:

- \$25.50 per horsepower billed on April 1
- \$25.50 per horsepower billed on August 1

**Energy Charge, per kWh:**

First 400 kWh's per Horsepower	\$ .1045
Over 400 kWh's per Horsepower	\$ .0740

**Horsepower Charge:** The horsepower charge shall be billed on April 1 and August 1 according to the Rates section of this rate schedule.

**Production Cost Adjustment (PCA):** A production cost adjustment may be applied to all energy charges based on the production cost adjustment received from the District's power supplier adjusted for line losses.

**Energy Charges:** Energy charges shall be billed on October 1 of each year.

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**Determination of Billing Horsepower:** The horsepower for billing purposes shall be the motor nameplate horsepower; the maximum horsepower input to the motor as determined by test; or the horsepower as calculated from an installed demand meter, whichever is appropriate as determined by the District. Minimum horsepower for billing purposes shall be three (3) horsepower for single-phase service and five (5) horsepower for three-phase service.

**Power Factor Adjustment:** Beginning January 1, 2022, all irrigation services, with a maximum kilowatt demand reading of 20 HP or greater for any 30-minute period between Fall Billings, will be subject to a Billing Demand adjustment when the power factor measured during the Billing Demand period is less than 93%. The Billing Demand for the service will be increased by the percentage that the customer's power factor measured during the Billing Demand period is below 93%. The adjusted Billing Demand is calculated by multiplying the recorded Billing Demand by 93% and dividing by the recorded power factor measured during the Billing Demand period.

**Charge for Non-Irrigation Use:** If a facility change is required to provide additional capacity for non-irrigation purposes, a charge shall be assessed annually of \$14.00 per kVA for 60% of the additional transformer capacity required. Energy used shall be billed at the rate of 6.8¢ per kilowatt-hour on or about December 15 of each year.

**Minimum Bill:** Operated - The fixed charge, based on horsepower as determined by the District, or the minimum horsepower, if applicable.

**Late Charge:** Accounts where payments have not been received by the due date indicated on the bill shall be assessed a late payment charge as described in the District's "Customer Service Charges Rate Schedule".

**Municipal Lease Fee and/or Franchise Fee:** When the District has an agreement to lease the electric distribution facilities of a village, the District agrees to pay the village a percentage of the revenue derived from the customers served from the facilities owned by the community. The lease or franchise amount shall be added to each customer's monthly bill.

**Service Regulations:** Service under this rate schedule is subject to the District's Rules and Regulations.
