NON-RESIDENTIAL SERVICE

Available: To all customers located in the general service area of the District.

Applicable: For non-residential service where the billing demand does not exceed 5 kW and the annual consumption does not exceed 4,000 kWhs annually. Not available for commercial, crop irrigation or grain bin use.

Character of Service: Alternating current, 60 cycles, single-phase, at any of the District's standard secondary voltages. Service shall be supplied year-round at request of the customer.

<u>Rates:</u>	Annual Customer Charge	\$238.00
	Energy Charge, per kWh	\$.055

Annual Customer Charge: The annual customer charge shall be billed on April 1 of each year. The annual customer charge shall not be prorated for partial year service. The customer charge will be considered due and payable if the District is not notified by May 1 of each year.

Production Cost Adjustment (PCA): A production cost adjustment may be applied to all energy charges based on the production cost adjustment received from the District's power supplier adjusted for line losses.

Energy Charges: Energy charges for usage shall be billed on or about April 1 of each year.

Late Charge: Accounts where payments have not been received by the due date indicated on the bill shall be assessed a late payment charge as described in the District's "Customer Service Charges Rate Schedule".

Nebraska State Sales Tax: The Nebraska state sales tax shall be applied to all charges unless a valid tax exemption certificate is filed by the customer.

Municipal Lease Fee and/or Franchise Fee: When the District has an agreement to lease the electric distribution facilities of a village, the District agrees to pay the village a percentage of the revenue derived from the customers served from the facilities owned by the community. The lease or franchise amount shall be added to each customer's monthly bill.

Gross Revenue Tax Charge: Customers residing within the corporate limits of an incorporated town or village shall be charged 5% of the monthly bill as a gross revenue tax.

Service Regulations: Service under this rate schedule is subject to the District's Rules and Regulations.
