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PRODUCTION COST ADJUSTMENT - "PCA"

Available: To all customers located in the general service area of the District.

Applicable: The Production Cost Adjustment (PCA) is a charge or credit that accounts for an increase or decrease in charges Southern Public Power District receives from its wholesale power supplier, Nebraska Public Power District. The PCA includes an adjustment for system line losses. The PCA is applied to all sales of energy under the retail rate schedule that provides for an adjustment to the energy charges using this PCA rate schedule.

Purpose: To apply an adjustment to all energy sales to reflect the refunding or excess rate stabilization funds by NPPD which exceeded the limits set forth in the 2015 Wholesale Power Contract. The PCA will be in effect from January 2025 through December 2025.
