



TOTAL ELECTRIC RURAL RESIDENTIAL AND FARM SERVICE

Available: To all customers located in the rural areas of the general service area of the District.

Applicable: To single family private dwelling units, including adjacent farm buildings, and for limited other ordinary farm use where service is supplied through one meter and where electricity is the only energy used for lighting, heating and water heating. To qualify for this rate, the residence must have at least ten (10) kilowatts of permanently installed electric heat which is used as the primary source of heat. Electricity must be the only source of power used in the residence for water heating, cooking, and other uses. Exceptions to this requirement shall include gas cooking stoves, wood burning fireplaces and gas assisted fireplaces. Not available for crop irrigation or grain drying.

Character of Service: Alternating current, 60 cycles, single and three-phase, at any of the District's standard secondary voltages.

Summer and Winter Seasons: The summer rates shall apply to customer bills rendered between June 15 and October 15. The winter rates shall apply to customer bills rendered in the remaining months of the year.

Production Cost Adjustment (PCA): A production cost adjustment may be applied to all energy charges based on the production cost adjustment received from the District's power supplier adjusted for line losses.

Annual Three-Phase Service Charge: In addition to the monthly rate, three-phase services or combination services shall be billed an annual three-phase service charge of \$65.00 or \$3.25 per kVA of required transformer capacity. The annual three-phase service charge shall be billed on September 1 of each year.

Annual Minimum: The annual minimum under this rate shall be \$15.00 per installed kVA per year exclusive of any applicable annual three-phase service charge, or \$276.00, whichever is greater. Customers not meeting their annual minimum shall be billed the appropriate amount upon disconnection of service or in December of each year.

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Late Charge: Accounts where payments have not been received by the due date indicated on the bill shall be assessed a late payment charge as described in the District's "Customer Service Charges Rate Schedule".

Nebraska State Sales Tax: The Nebraska state sales tax shall be applied to all charges unless a valid tax exemption certificate is filed by the customer.

Service Regulations: Service under this rate schedule is subject to the District's Rules and Regulations.
