

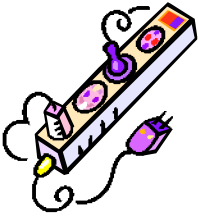
BRIGHT IDEAS

HOME ELECTRICAL SAFETY TEST

Electric outlets are not overloaded with plugs.

All electric cords are in good condition.

There are no electric cords under rugs, furniture legs, or near hot appliances.



Electric appliances are used away from water.

Appliances are not carried by the cord, or unplugged by tugging on the cord.

A multipurpose fire extinguisher is in your house.



Electric appliances that can get hot, such as toasters, lamps, heaters, etc., are kept away from things and surfaces that can burn.

Safety caps are inserted into outlets when small children are around.

Small appliances are turned off and/or unplugged when people leave home.



All extension cords, lights, and appliances used outdoors are labeled for outdoor use.
